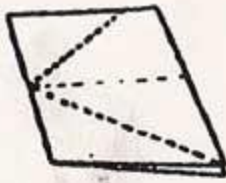

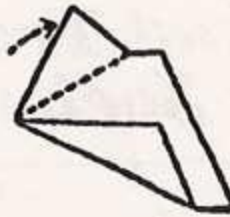

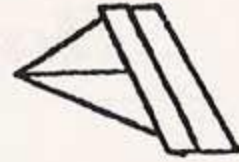
Newspaper Cap



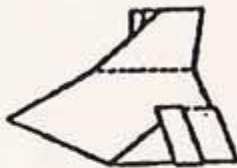
1.

Crease at dotted lines.



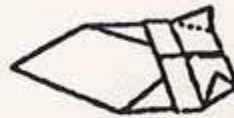
2.

closed edge to centre line.



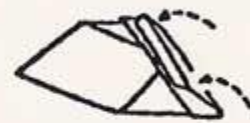
3.
Fold top edge back to meet
triangle. Fold it again to form
cuff over triangle. Turn paper
over.



4.
Fold base of triangle in to
centre. Short fold = large hat,
beyond centre = small hat.



5.
Fold in the right angle
corners to meet the cuff.



6.
Fold resulting truncated cone
over the cuff and tuck it in.



7.
Fold down apex of triangle
and fold it into cuff. You now
have a rectangle.



8.
Pull hat open wide and fold
down the "ears".



9.
Tuck the ears into the cuffs.



10.
Square the hat, creasing the
corners and wear it with pride.

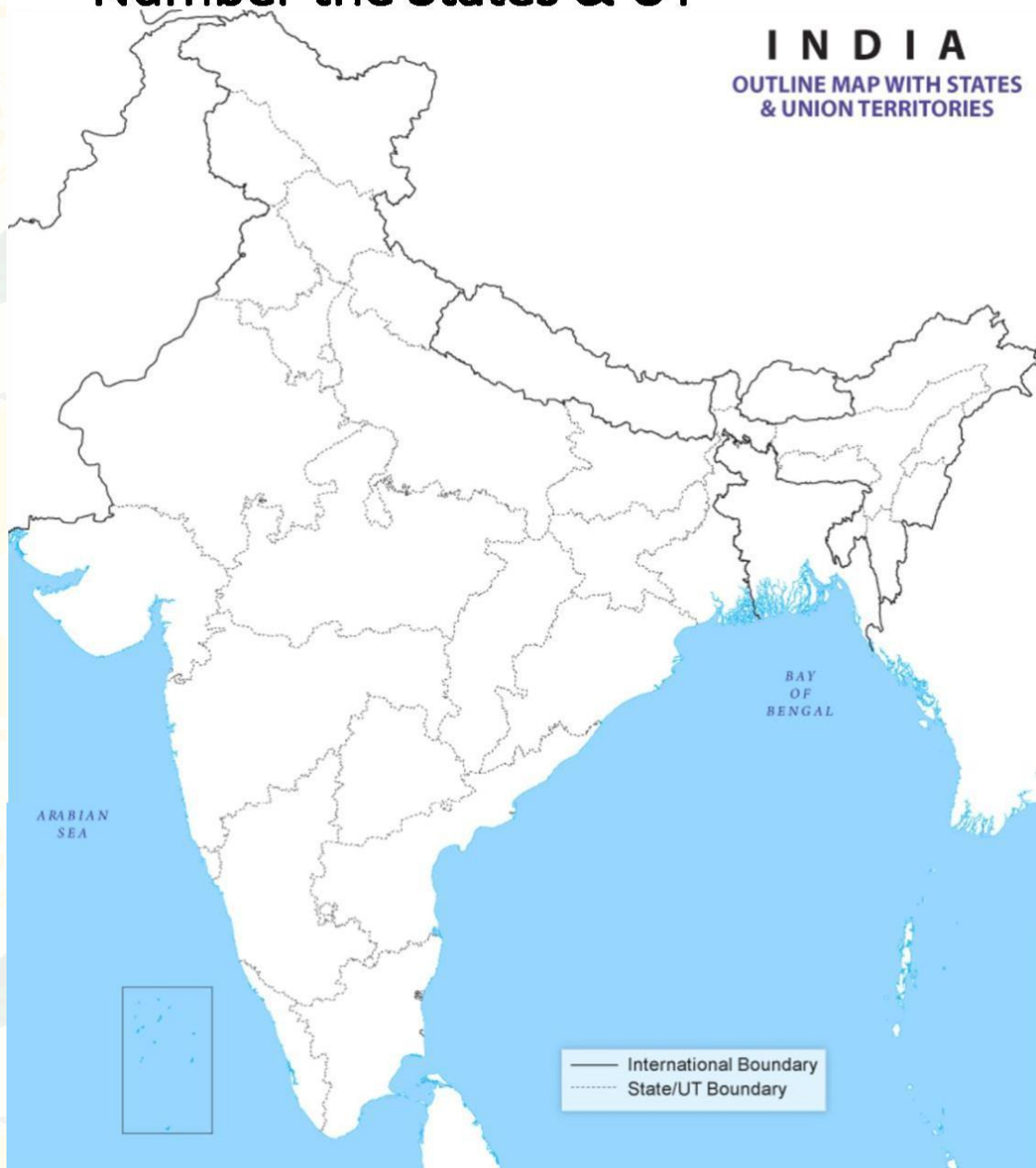
